

## **PRAGUE OPEN 2017 Warhammer 40k championship army lists**

Submit your army lists until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017 at [info@gamemat.eu](mailto:info@gamemat.eu) in Battlescribe format (without rules)

- ✓ Army must be 1850 points or less and be battle-forged.
- ✓ Must be composed of maximum 2 unique detachments chosen from Combined Arms Detachments, Ally detachments, Codex detachments or Formations.
- ✓ Detachments consisting of multiple formations may include duplicate formations, and are still considered a single detachment. Example, you may include 2 demi-companies in a single Gladius detachment, but you may only include a single Gladius detachment in your army.
- ✓ Come the apocalypse allies are not allowed. This means also if your army would treat summoned Daemons as come the apocalypse allies, then they are not allowed to summon them.
- ✓ Super Heavy Vehicles and/or Gargantuan Monstrous Creatures are allowed.
- ✓ No more than 550 points may be spent on Super Heavy Vehicles and/or Gargantuan Monstrous Creatures.
- ✓ Imperial Knight Detachment is exempt to 550 points limitation.
- ✓ All current GW source material released before March 21<sup>st</sup> is allowed, including GW Codexes, Data Slates, Formations with exception of:
  - ✗ The Death from the Skies supplement
  - ✗ Apocalypse War Zone supplements, Apocalypse Formations
- ✓ Forge World units and army lists are allowed with exception of:
  - ✗ Horus Heresy/30K Forge World units
  - ✗ Units with Experimental Rules only
  - ✗ The Dark Harvest army list is not allowed
- ✓ Fortifications may be selected as long as you have fortification slot available as part of a force organisation chart with exception of:
  - ✗ Fortification Networks
  - ✗ Void Shield Generators
  - ✗ Fortifications with AV 15

### **General Notes:**

- The Warhammer 40,000 7th Edition Rules and all relevant Official Games Workshop Errata and FAQs will be used. In the case of a conflict between a printed and digital versions, the most recent update or FAQ will take precedence.
- In not clear cases judge will decide for you.
- Any player with Forge World models in their army list should have a copy of all rules relating to these selections with them and should explicitly talk their opponent through these rules prior to the game. You must use the most current version of the Forge World Book.
- Players must use the same army list and same warlord throughout the tournament.
- Each player must bring a Warhammer 40,000 rulebook, the most currently published rules for all units represented in their army and all materials needed to play a game/report the results - including dice, measuring devices, templates, and a writing implement.
- Battles will be limited 3 hours game time.
- All models must be WYSIWYG and painted with minimum 3 colors.
- Swiss pairing system is used for match-ups.
